TERMS & CONDITIONS (SOCIETY)

- 1.** Provisional bookings will only be held for 14 days until a signed booking form and deposit have been received.
- 2.** A non-refundable deposit of £10 per person is required when booking. Please note that no tee times will be reserved without a **FULL** deposit.
- 3.** Cancellations must be notified in writing a minimum of 4 weeks prior to the event. Failure to do so will result in a full charge being levied.
Any reduction in numbers within the 48 hours will be charged for in full.
- 4.** Numbers for golf must be confirmed 14 days prior to the society day. Any reduction in numbers after confirmation will result in the loss of deposit for the difference
- 5.** Numbers for catering must be confirmed at least 7 days prior to the society day. Any catering cancellations after that time or on the day will still require full payment.
- 6.** In the event of The Company having to cancel the booking for unforeseen reasons, a full refund will be made.
- 7.** Dress Code- Golf shoes and collared shirt or roll neck sweater must be worn. No jeans, track suites. Shorts must be tailored and of moderate length. Shirts to be tucked into trousers at all times. Failure to comply with the dress code will result in refusal of entry onto the course, but still charges.
- 8.** Signatories on the booking form are authorised to act on behalf of the named group or as their agent.
- 9.** Neither the Company, its agents or servants shall be held responsible for any claims for loss or damage to property or for any injuries sustained by those visiting the premises.
- 10.** In the event of any damage on or to the premises by players in the party of, the Client will be held liable.
- 11.** The Company does not accept responsibility for the group's failure to complete the rounds/competition due to inclement weather conditions.
All Golf and Catering arrangements must be paid for on arrival, if you require invoicing after the event, please contact the Golf Office before your golf day.



NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF VISITORS



Society organisers are responsible for ensuring that all members of their party are aware of these rules before their arrival at the club in order to avoid embarrassment and ensure that your day at Park Hill Golf Club is as enjoyable as possible.

1. Payment for all society packages must be made to the Club Secretary **BEFORE** commencing play. **ALL** players must report to the Pro shop before commencing play.
2. Play will be from the **YELLOW TEES** as a **FOUR BALL** unless authorised by prior arrangement.
3. All players are expected to adhere to the rules of Golf and show regard for the etiquette and courtesies of the Game. Consideration should be given to the care of the course (divots and pitch marks must be repaired). Particular attention should be paid to the speed of play. Players in club competitions must be allowed to play through.
4. On the course a strict dress code applies and must be adhered to! This includes no jeans, shirts must have collars, no trainers etc and a soft spike only rule is in place. In the clubhouse the 'Park Hill Dress Code' now allows the wearing of smart casual clothing including **denim clothing, training shoes, shirts without collars but doesn't not allow for work wear, tracksuits or printed wear with large motifs i.e. football tops**. Tucking trousers into socks is not permitted. In hot weather smart tailored shorts are permitted but must be worn with calf length socks. No wet or soiled clothing is permitted in the bar and metal spikes are strictly forbidden in any area of the clubhouse or on the course. Soft spikes are permitted in the bar area if essential. The correct place to change, including shoes, is in the changing rooms.
5. The club will not accept any liability for any injury, loss or damage whatsoever caused to any member of the party or to their clothing, equipment, money, valuables or any other articles and also in respect of their vehicles and contents which are parked at the owners risk.
6. In the interest of everyone's comfort & enjoyment **mobile phones** must be switched off at all times both on the course and in the clubhouse!

Anyone failing to adhere to these rules will not be allowed to play the course!
